Confirmation

A place is confirmed only after written acceptance or invitation, required information, applicable terms and payment where relevant.

Included

Published two-day proceeding, participant materials, working-table participation, expressly stated refreshments and meals, and selected post-Assembly materials.

Not included

Travel, accommodation, visas, insurance, airport transfers, optional hospitality, guests, extra seats, private rooms and independent professional services unless expressly stated.

Preparation

Profile, cross-border question, jurisdictional insight, corridor interest, contribution and continuation interest.

Conduct and attribution

Professional behaviour, privacy, no mass solicitation, on-record/non-attributed/confidential session rules and no unauthorised recording.

One principal room

The leaders' proceeding is designed around a concentrated shared room.

Registration details

Final room, desk and access instructions will be issued to confirmed participants.

Advance notice

Participants should communicate reasonable accessibility requirements as early as possible.

Participants remain responsible for travel, accommodation and immigration requirements.

Verified hotel booking routes, room-block terms and local travel details should be published only after formal confirmation.

Plan sufficient arrival time

International participants are encouraged to arrive before the first Assembly morning.

Not included unless stated

Participants may stay at the venue hotel or arrange accommodation independently.

Authority decides

UNBOUNDED may issue a confirmation letter after participation is confirmed; approval remains with the relevant authority.

Participant responsibility

Appropriate medical, cancellation and travel-disruption cover is recommended.

Participation is deliberately limited to preserve the integrity of the leaders' proceeding.

Who may participate

Managing and senior partners, founders, practice leaders, neutrals, former judges, tax and accounting leaders, business advisers, governance leaders, academics and institutional heads with genuine cross-border relevance.

Role of a participating leader

Deliberations, jurisdictional interventions, declaration review, working sessions, signatory consideration and post-Assembly mandates.

Participation review

Professional standing, relevance, jurisdictional perspective, institutional contribution, seriousness and potential continuation.

Barcelona-only route

A limited approved place may be offered independently of Annual Standing, without year-round Concierge, Dashboard, delegation, corridor or standing privileges.

No pay-to-sign

Fees, sponsorship and participation payments do not purchase declaration language, signatory status, resolutions, recognition or governance influence.

Request

Submit your role, organisation, jurisdiction, principal question, corridor interest, possible contribution and signatory or working-group interest.
